General Information about School Excursions

On days when we go on excursions, please make sure your child is equipped with the following:

The costs for this excursion (bus costs) will be announced and debited from your account together with the other costs in July. Please note that the costs for the bus trip must be paid even if your child does not attend, as these expenses will not be reimbursed.

Policy on Early Dismissal Due to Heat



There is no legal regulation that requires schools to dismiss students early once a certain temperature is reached. This decision is solely at the discretion of the school administration.

We will inform you in advance by email (usually one day ahead) if early dismissal due to heat is announced. As before, your child will still have the option to stay at school until 2:00 p.m. and then attend the regular afternoon care program.
